## Science - Technology - Innovation

- 1. Launch of a research program for Indo-French projects on "Science and Information Technology" (co-funded by DST, CNRS and Inria)
- 2. Launch of a research program for Indo-French projects on "Challenges in the field of health" (to be implemented by CEFIPRA): 1/ Innovative ICT based solutions for Health; 2/ Implementable medical devices, targeted delivery systems and biocaptors; 3/ Nanobiotechnologies
- 3. *Memorandum of Understanding* between CEFIPRA and Saint Gobain Research India for launching a research programme on "Habitat in hot and humid climate" (followed by the opening, within six months, of post-doctoral scholarships funded by Saint Gobain for French scientists desiring to come to India).
- 4. Letter of Intent between CEFIPRA and EADS to launch an aerospace research programme.
- 5. Memorandum of Understanding for the International Associated Laboratory (LIA) for research on liver diseases between Inserm and the Institute of Liver and Biliary Sciences.

- 10. Statement of Intent between Morpho-Safran and Gujarat Forensic Sciences University for Training, Research and Development
- 11. Creation of an India-France mathematics fund at the "Institut des Hautes Etudes Scientifiques" (financed by private companies, initial contribution by TOTAL).
- 12. Decision by "Association nationale de la recherche et la technologie" (ANRT National association for research and technology) to open its doctoral scholarships in industrial environment to Indian students (« Cifre »).
